Continuing Traditions at John Paul II Academy

The Church has had a long tradition of presenting Bible stories, parables, and events in the lives of Jesus and his Apostles through plays. Especially before the Bible was printed, plays were the most effective way for teaching these stories and were usually presented in the parish church. At the Academy, we continue that activity through Christmas and Lenten presentations.

One Lenten practice that has now become a "tradition" at John Paul II Academy is the Living Stations presentation that Mrs. Patti Shumiloff directs each year for both the Academy and the parishes. All of the eighth grade students serve as actors, actresses, or choir members in this production, and many of their siblings are included in the scenes where Jesus meets the citizens of Jerusalem

None of the actors have speaking parts. Consequently, the beauty of the Living Stations lies in the actions and musical renditions of the presentation itself. Who the students are, recedes behind the characters they portray! The group began practicing after school the first week of Lent – from Monday through Thursday, and continue this schedule until the first performance this week. The commitment of time is tremendous, yet our students do it because they know the power drama has to impact a person's faith. Each year I think the current Living Stations will not outperform the previous presentation, but it always does!

The Living Stations are a beautiful introduction to the Holiest of Weeks and the Easter Triduum. On Thursday afternoon, March 25th, the Living Stations will be presented for the entire JP II Family at 1:30 PM in St. Therese Church. (If this time fits your schedule, please feel free to join us.) Although our students have seen the two previous re-enactments, they are always awed and come to realize the tremendous sacrifice of love Jesus made to redeem us on the cross.

Two additional performances being presented in the parishes, Friday, March 26th, the Living Stations will be performed at St. Therese Church in place of the regular stations and Mass. **On Palm Sunday, March 28th, the Living Stations will be performed at Saints Peter and Paul Church at 7:00 PM.** I truly hope that you can attend one of these two performances because I firmly believe God will touch your heart through the drama and songs of our students.

Be assured of our prayers for you in this holiest of seasons. I will not be sending in an article for next week because your bulletins will be VERY full with the information you need to truly walk in the footsteps of the Lord. However, look for a brief article on Easter Sunday!
